Uploading video/audio files is also available. Recording is done with a standalone application that must be downloaded to the machine. The mobile app also has limited recording capabilities. Students have the ability to also make recordings in YuJa sites that they are enrolled in. This option is active by default, but may be disabled if desired through Course Settings.

Instructors have the ability to edit the transcription to increase accuracy. Human captioning is available through UND Disability Services for Students, for students requiring accommodations.
