

UND Admission Requirements for Students Educated in the Netherlands

Please note: These are minimum requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.

Freshman Applicants

Minimum High School Course Preparation

- 4 years of native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry, or physics)
- 3 years of social studies

Minimum Academic Requirements

- Applicants with the *VWO (diploma of university preparatory education)* will be considered for admission provided they have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of **7.0/10** in academic subjects.
- Applicants with the *HAVO (diploma of senior general secondary education)* may be considered if they meet the **Minimum High School Course Preparation** listed above, and have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of **7.0/10** in academic subjects.
- Applicants with *International Baccalaureate Diploma*: Full IB diploma holders meet university CGPA requirements.

Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)

- The SAT is not *required* for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned schools.

Transfer Applicants

Minimum Academic Requirements

The minimum cumulative GPA requirement for admission in all transferable courses is 6.5/10
