St. Peter's Basilica



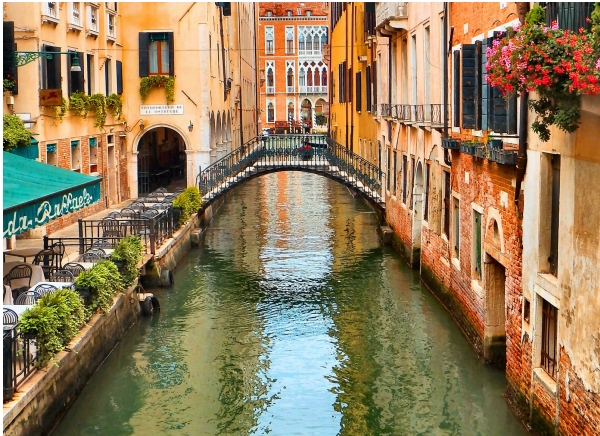
Vatican City
