Undergraduate and or Graduate, if appropriate: The reference to determining learning outcomes was reported in the Annual Report and was applicable to undergraduate and graduate students. Although the learning outcomes (goals) were not clearly presented in the statement of goals, the learning goals were recorded in the results or outcomes. For example, in the judicial office hearing training, the results included learning goals such as communications, critical thinking/problem solving. 2. Comments: Multiple activities were included in the report that directly addressed individual goals. These activities did not address student learning outcomes, but were geared at reporting measures such as continuing the parental notification program for students involved in alcohol-related violations and participation on the national task force for Prevention of Violence and Crisis Management on Campus. The one assessment measure that was done was a survey to student judicial hearing officers as part of the assessment of judicial officer training.
