Transfer credits will be evaluated and applied according to the current catalog and the approved Essential Studies list at the first semester of enrollment at UND.

A concentration in a single supplementary field other than Anthropology is also required. This may be met in two ways: 1) a language proficiency of level IV or 2) 20 semester hours in a single subject taught at UND--9 of which must be 300 or above.
