Transfer credits will be evaluated and applied according to the current catalog and the approved Essential Studies list at the first semester of enrollment at UND.

Completion of an AS Degree in Nurs from RCTC and a current RN license may make one eligible for the UND online RN to BSN program. See www.nursing.und.edu for more information.
