Essential Studies equivalencies, courses, and major requirements may change. An official evaluation of transfer credit will be done upon admission to the university. Transfer credits will be evaluated and applied according to the current catalog and the approved Essential Studies list at the first semester of enrollment at UND.

* However, all UND students- including transfers- are required to take a UND Essential Studies upper division capstone (C) course. Approved courses are taken the senior year of a student's program of study.
