

Senate Budget Restructuring and Reallocation Committee update 4/25

The SBRRC received five budget-related comments submitted through the University Senate's [Feedback and Suggestions website](#) this past week. These comments and our responses are posted at the University Senate [Budget Information page](#). Comments focus on tuition and credits, Grand Challenges, One-Stop, reporting program cuts, and frequent flier miles. There is also a follow-up on strategic planning costs.

Budget-related developments:

- The 65th legislative assembly approved a [budget for Higher Education](#) on April 27. The budget is now in the hands of the governor.
- The April 26 Budget Forum (3 pm Education 7) will focus on the Learning and Engagement pillars. The combined April 19, 26 Strategic Planning [Powerpoint presentation](#) is available on the [Strategic Planning website](#).

- President Kennedy will address the Strategic Plan at the meeting of the University Council on May 3, 3-4 pm, Education 7.
