

COST & AID

Factors such as your specific program, where you live now, your military status and whether you choose to attend class online or on campus can affect your tuition rate. The best way to figure out what UND will really cost you is to calculate your cost with financial aid. The actual price you pay usually is far less once your custom financial aid package is considered.

Rates: Based on the 2025-26 tuition rates in U.S. dollars. Rates include mandatory fees but do **not** include a one-time new incoming student fee, flight/aviation costs, study abroad, music lessons, marching band, student teaching or select physical education course rental expenses. **Tuition and fees are subject to change for the 2026-27 academic year.**

On-Campus Students: Estimated costs are based on the full-time tuition rate (capped at 12 credits per semester), the average cost of a double occupancy room and the cost of the Anytime Access Silver meal plan for the fall and spring semesters. Semester-based online courses are included in the 12-credit tuition cap and will be billed based on your residency rate.

Online Programs: Tuition is charged per credit regardless of residency. Online tuition is **not** capped at 12 credits per semester, however, an online program's mandatory fees are capped at 12 credits per semester.

Enroll Anytime Online Courses: Tuition for self-paced, enroll anytime courses is billed at the online base tuition rate regardless of residency or number of credits taken. Enroll anytime courses do not qualify for financial aid or military tuition assistance, do not have mandatory fees and are not included in the tuition cap.

Military Tuition: Active duty military members using federal Tuition Assistance (TA) are eligible for an undergraduate tuition rate of \$250 / credit. Active duty military tuition rates are not valid for any aerospace programs. Military veterans and dependents are eligible to receive the North Dakota in-state tuition rate. To receive military benefits, you must follow the military admissions process.

Financial Aid

It's our priority to help students afford UND. Each year, **79%** of our undergrad students share more than **\$107 million** in financial aid, including scholarships, grants and loan programs. On average, UND students receive **\$13,500** annually in aid.

The **Free Application for Federal Student Aid** is the *only* application UND requires to determine your eligibility for federal financial aid programs. The aid you're eligible to receive is determined from the financial information you provide in your FAFSA and the cost to attend UND. Don't assume you won't be eligible for aid! Most students qualify for some type of aid, including low-interest federal student loans.

Scholarship Central

Once you're admitted to UND, you can search and apply annually for more than 1,300 scholarships with one simple application at Scholarship Central. The application opens **Oct. 1** and closes **Feb. 1** for the 2026-27 academic year.

UND APPLICATION PROCESS

Apply early for more financial aid, scholarships, housing and class options.

1. Meet Admissions Requirements

Carefully review the Freshman Admissions Requirements at [UND.edu/admissions/freshmen](https://und.edu/admissions/freshmen) to learn what is required to be admitted to UND.

2. Complete Application

Complete the online application and pay a \$35 nonrefundable fee at [UND.edu/admissions](https://und.edu/admissions) up to one year in advance of when you plan to attend UND.

ADMISSIONS APPLICATION

Use your UND admissions application to:

- Start, save and submit your online application.
- Check your application status.
- View your application checklist.
- See admission decisions.
- Confirm your enrollment.

You will receive emails throughout the process on the status of your application. It's your responsibility to ensure all submitted materials are received and attached to the application. Please monitor your admissions application account and the email you used to apply.

FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE

To automatically be awarded the UND Freshman Scholarship, you must meet the criteria. You're encouraged to submit your completed application by the **Feb. 1 priority deadline** for the upcoming fall semester.

3. Request Transcripts

OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS

Request your official high school transcripts to be sent directly to UND. Transcripts can be sent electronically through a secured electronic transcript service or by mail in a sealed envelope to:

COLLEGE LEVEL CREDITS

If you've completed any college-level credits, request that your official college transcripts be sent directly from the college or university to UND with the directions above.

Note: If you completed dual credit through a North Dakota public institution and the credits appear on your official high school transcript, you do not need to request a college transcript.

REPORT GPA

It's recommended that you have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 (3.25 for Aviation Management and Commercial Aviation) or higher when applying. You can self-report your high school GPA or provide an unofficial transcript on your application for a quicker admission decision. You'll be asked to confirm your academic status by providing an official transcript at a later date and an additional final transcript after graduation.

If you don't meet the minimum guidelines, you're still encouraged to apply. You're more than your GPA, so we'll review your application closely to make the best decision for your success. For more detailed admission guidelines, visit [UND.edu/admissions](https://und.edu/admissions).

4. Request ACT/SAT Scores (Optional)

While ACT/SAT test scores are **not** required for admission, all students are encouraged to submit their test scores to best determine scholarships and course placement.
