Alimath Salou

Alimath Salou is a junior sprinter on the University of North Dakota women's track & field team, majoring in Criminal Justice Studies. A Fargo, N.D., native, she was a standout at Davies High School, helping her team win a state title in the 4x100m relay and earning multiple podium finishes at the NDHSAA State A Meet. At UND, Salou has continued to excel, posting strong personal bests and contributing to competitive relay performances for the Fighting Hawks. She is also active on campus through the Criminal Justice Association and the Hilyard Center, and she gains hands-on experience at the West Central Regional Juvenile Center in Moorhead, Minn., where she applies the knowledge she is developing through her academic work.



Eric Schmidt

A 2002 graduate of the University of North Dakota, Eric Schmidt is currently the head coach for the UND football team. Originally from Mandan, N.D., Schmidt is a former Fighting Hawks linebacker, captained UND's 2001 Division II national championship team and earned All-American honors during his playing career. He returned home to lead the program after a distinguished coaching career that included roles at San Diego State, the University of Washington, Fresno State and multiple prior tenures at UND, where he helped guide the defense to two FCS playoff appearances. Prior to his collegiate coaching career, he began as head coach at Crookston (Minn.) High School. Off the field, Schmidt and his wife, Tiffany, reside in Grand Forks with their daughter, Kennedy, and sons, Harrison and Truman.


