About the Survey

The UND Graduation Survey collects employment and demographic information from UND students at graduation.

The information collected in this survey is used by various offices across campus, as well as for university assessment purposes and to inform responses to questions from various stakeholders regarding employment and salary data.

Survey Response & Participants



In August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019, 3,130 students were candidates for degrees, with 850 graduates having participated in this survey, for a response rate of 27%

*August 2018: 134 survey participants of 518 candidates for graduation;
December 2018: 214 survey participants of 809 candidates for graduation;
May 2019: 502 participants of 1,803 candidates for graduation.*



Most of the respondents (69%) received an undergraduate degree (31% graduate degree)

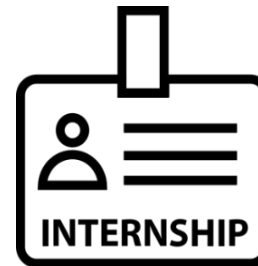

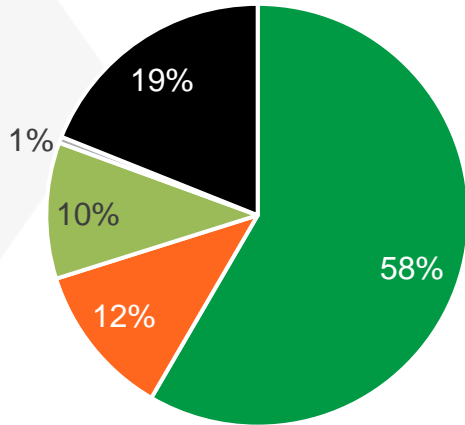

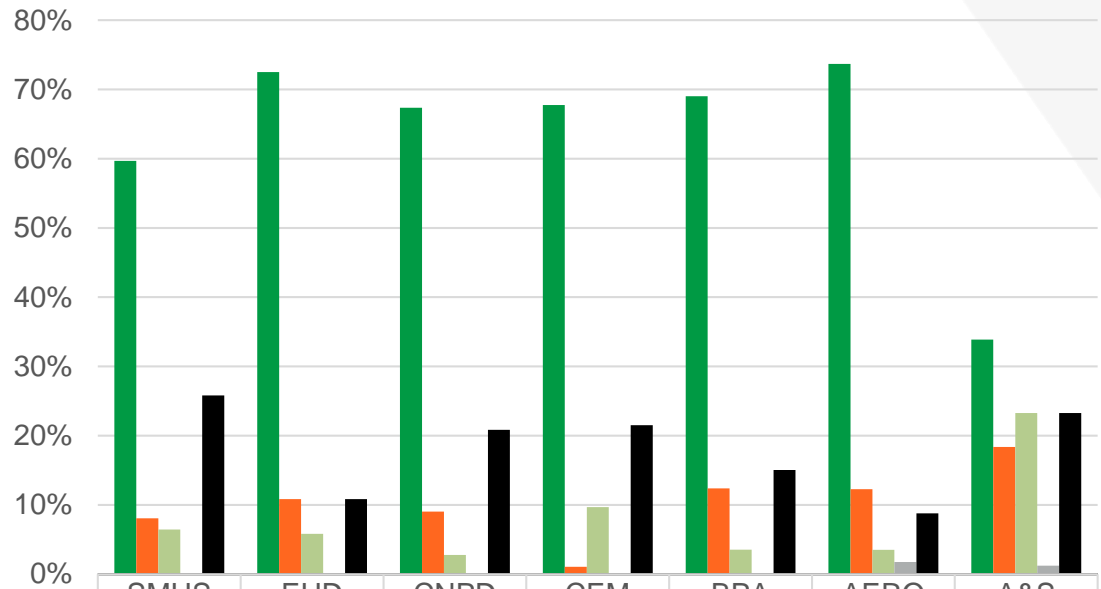

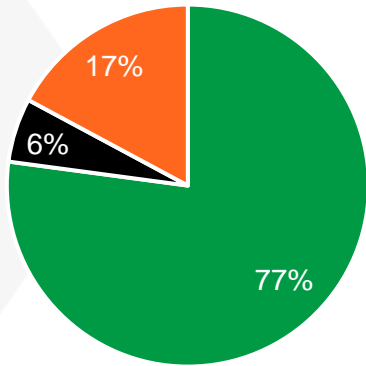

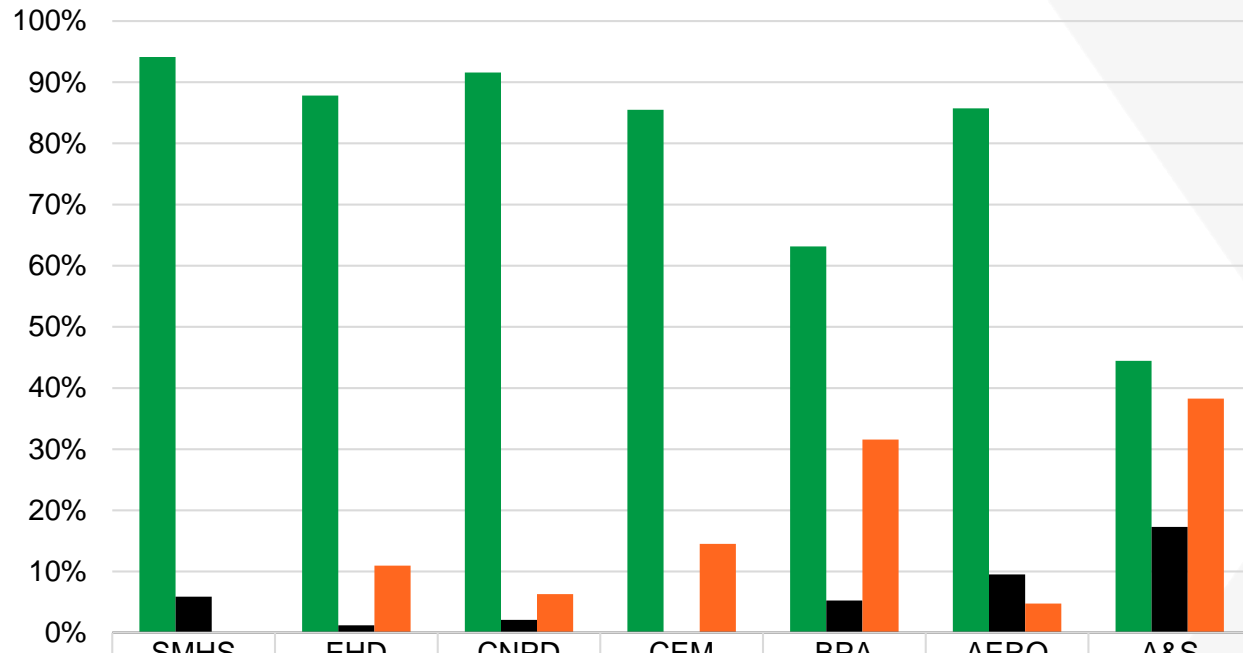
Job Relatedness to Degree

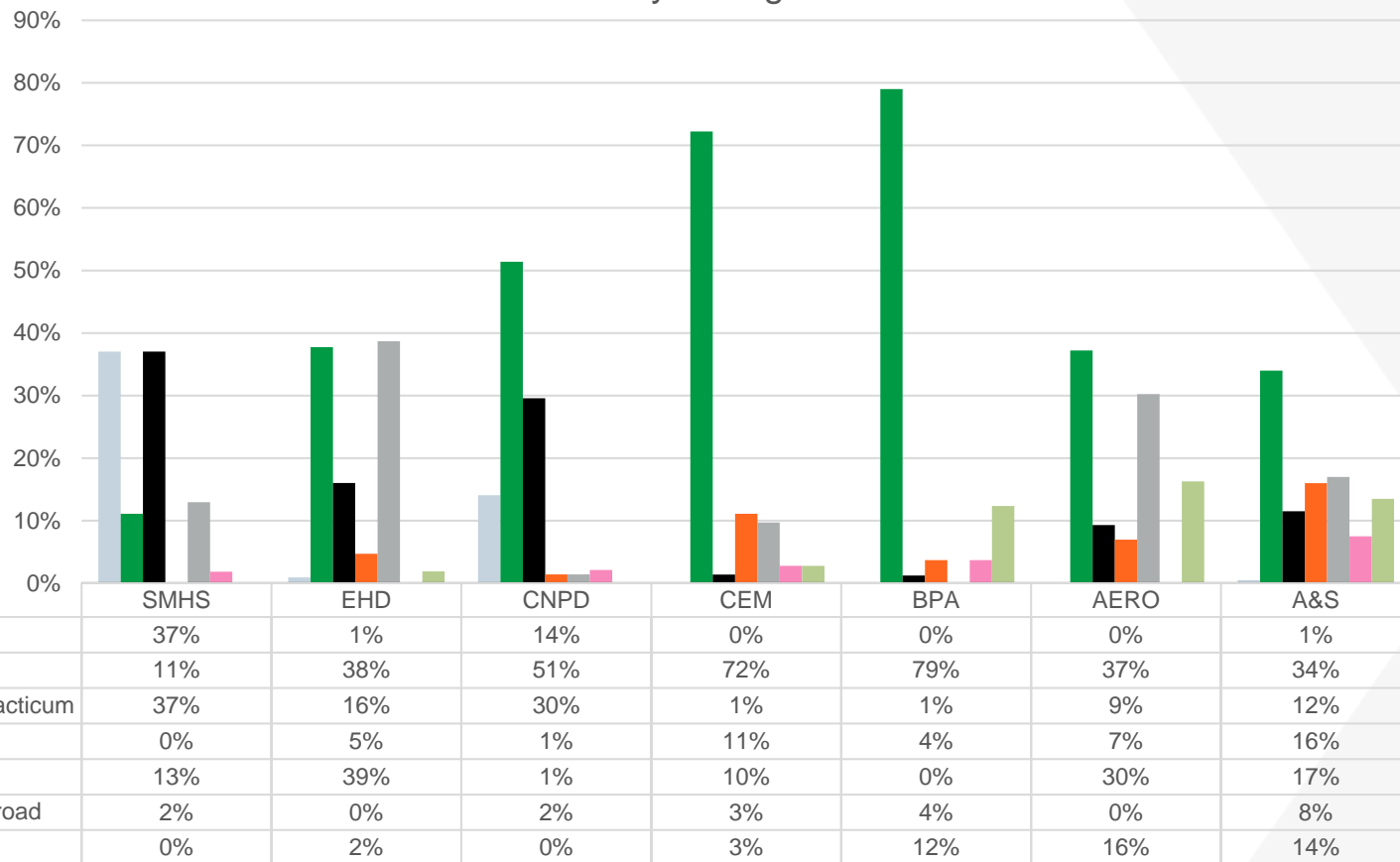
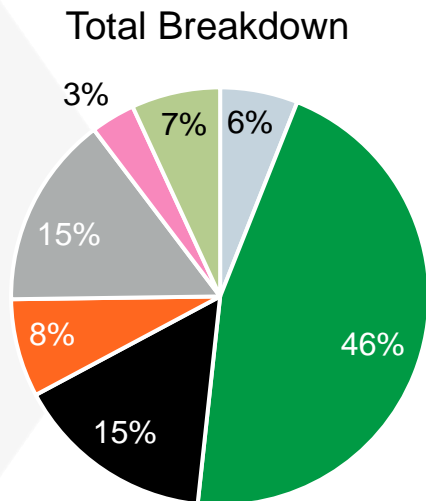

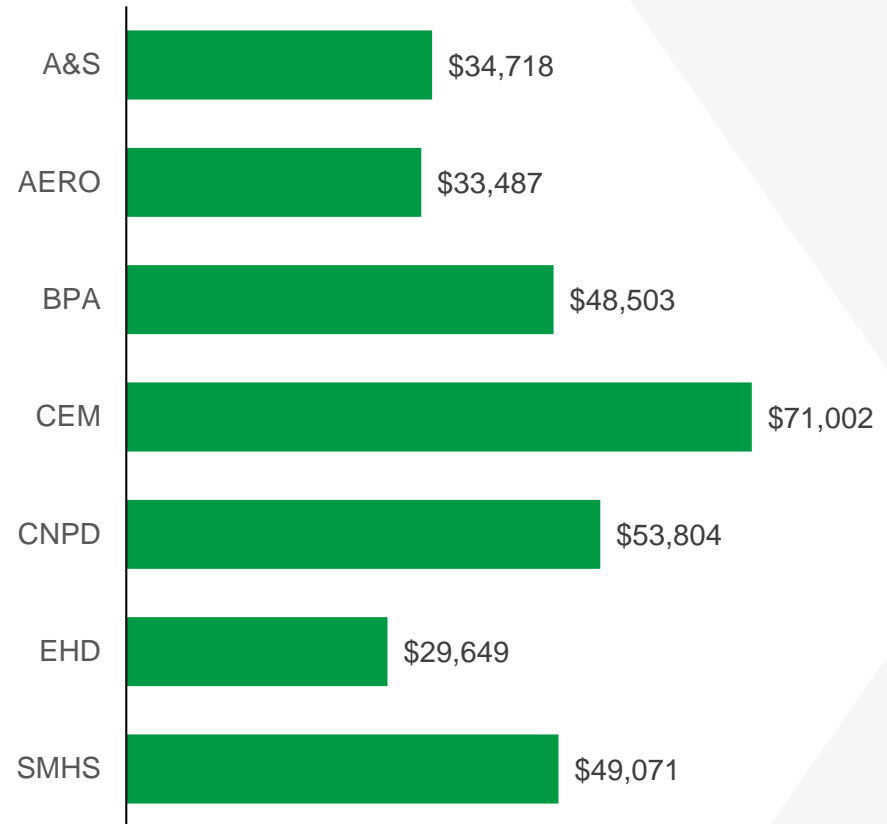

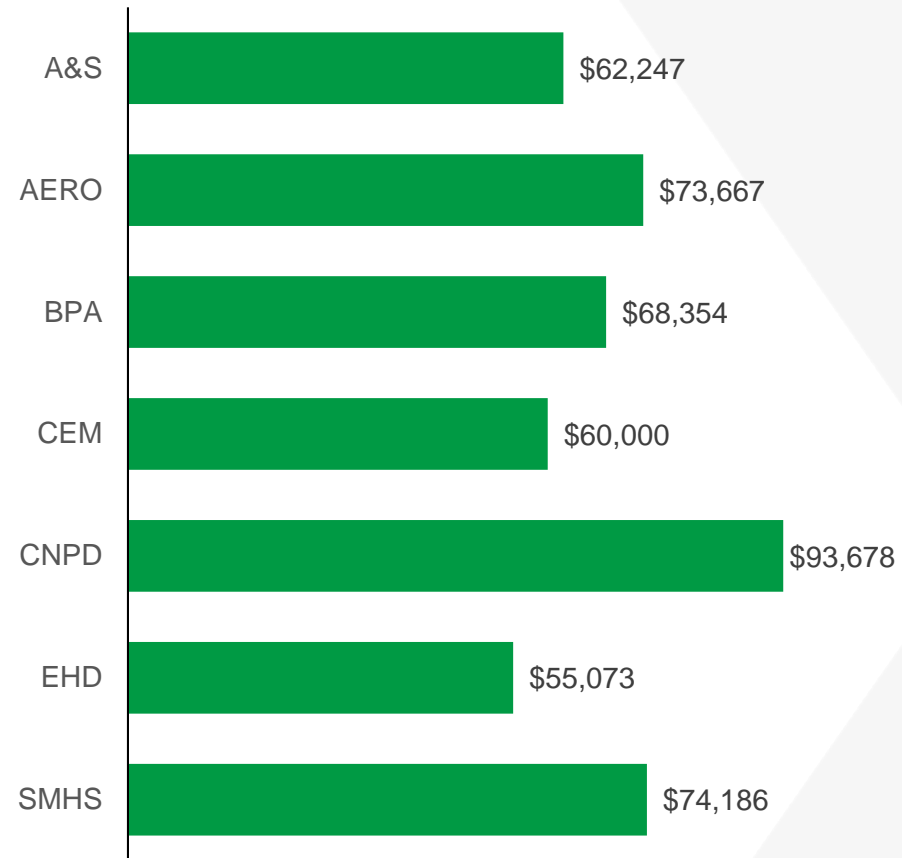

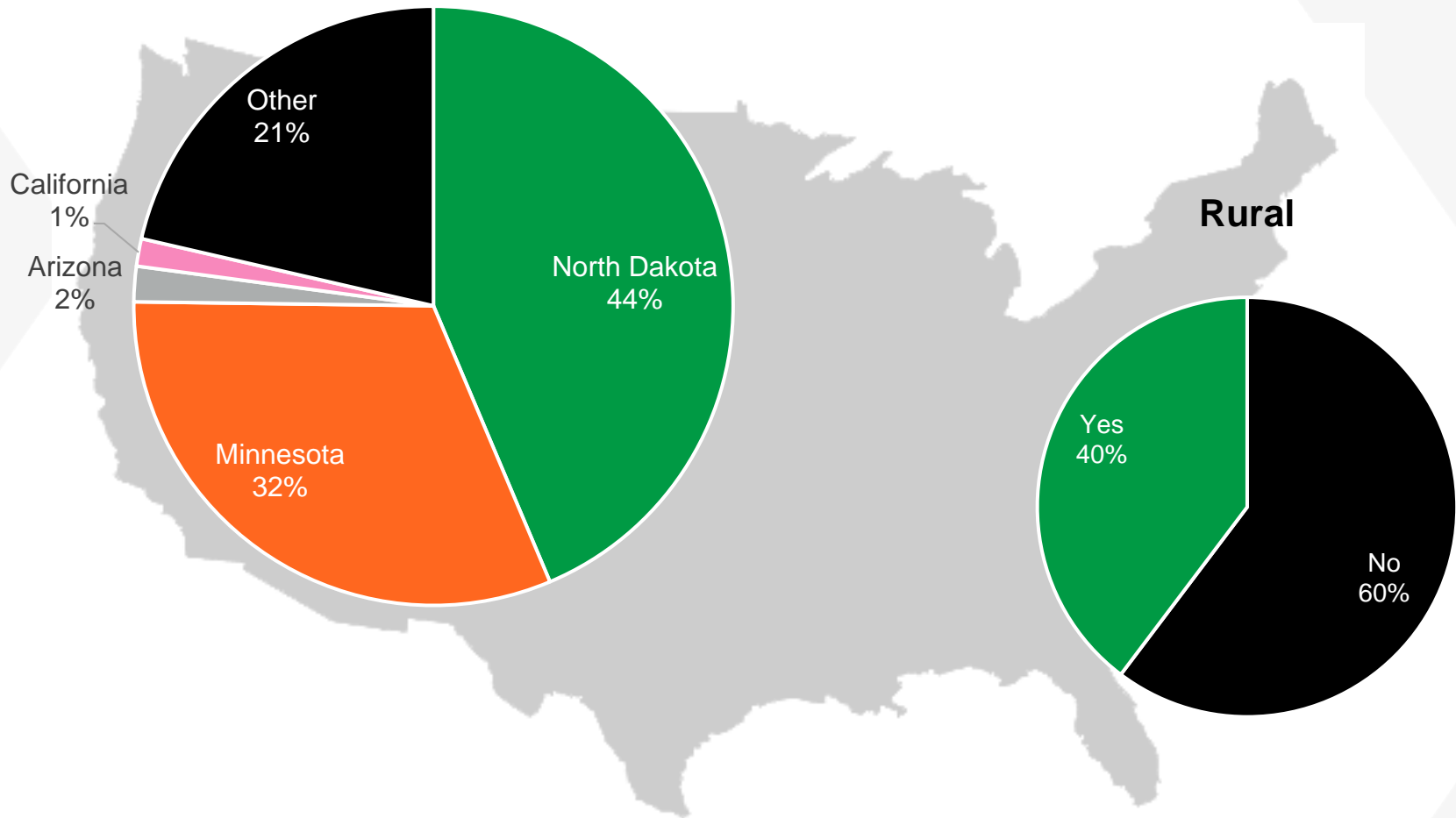
