

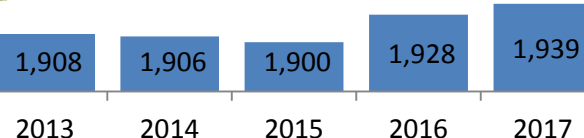

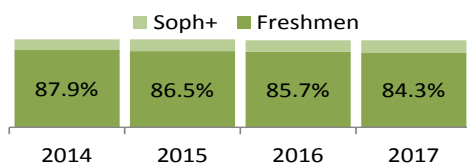
Five-Year Fall Enrollment



FYR beginning in summer: 2013 (29), 2014 (62), 2015 (43), 2016 (52)

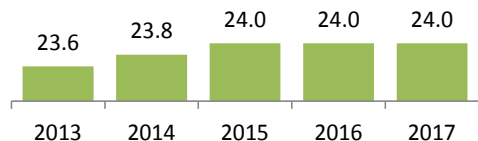
