Complete Records Check & Analysis of Reported concerns:



ALTERNATIVE RESPONSE ASSESSMENT IF:

- Infant ≤ 12 months old
- Report is regarding ONLY SEI

STANDARD CPS ASSESSMENT IF ANY APPLY:

- Infant > 12 months
- Report contains additional C A/N Concerns
- Siblings are under county/ DHS Custody (consider if CPS or AA to CM is most appropriate)
- Caregiver has Previous Services Required / Confirmed for Physical Abuse, Sexual Abuse or Medical
- History of: Failure to Thrive; Undetermined injury; Fatal Abuse/Neglect; Infant Death (sudden or unexpected)
- Immediate safety concerns Law enforcement and Juvenile Court need to be contacted



Contact Reporter

Complete Face to Face with Caregivers, Infant & Siblings (3 days or <) PRESENT DANGER Assessment/ Safety Plan





Provide parent with AR brochure & Agreement

Parent signs Agreement & all necessary ROIs

THREE Safety Supports



Assess Protective Capacities & Impending Danger

If plan is being followed, Complete TOOL 3

STAFF with CPS Supervisor and/or FSS upon completion


