Dropping a Course & Withdrawal Financial Implications

Important! Timing of drop/withdrawal may have financial implications.

- 100% Refund, 75% Refund, 50% Refund ([Dates & Deadlines](#)) – only for withdrawal to 0 credits

Repeating Course Work

- Once credit - a letter grade of "D" or better - has been earned in a course, a student may receive financial aid for only one additional (second) attempt of the same course, regardless of the earned grade for the second attempt.

UND Financial Aid Steps and Financial Aid Definitions

FAFSA Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a US Citizen
- Must maintain [SAP](#)
- Must be admitted to a degree seeking program at UND
- Must complete additional requirements as requested.
- Must be enrolled half time.
 - Undergrad 6+
 - Grad/Law 5+
 - Summer: Law 3+
 - Grad 5+

SAP FAQ Answers:

- SAP status is based on prior term's progress and is cumulative – evaluated after grades post each term
- Petitions always due by first day of class and mid-June for Summer term
- Students should submit petition ASAP even if documentation from advisor is not ready
- All attempted credits are counted by career, not program – a student's transfer credits will factor in.
- Having excess credits due to changing majors, transfer, or previous degree is an acceptable extenuating circumstance.
- Completion Rate = all successfully completed credits / all attempted credits (repeats and Ws included) must be 66.67%+
- Warning Status: student is not meeting SAP but has a term to try meet on their own before disqualification
- Info Status: Student is approaching maximum credits – they may need to petition if they won't finish their degree by limit

Internship – follows regular fed aid guidelines

CO-OP – 2 credit CO-OP= 12 credits, 1 Credit CO-OP= 6 credits

Collaborative Enrollment – must complete collaborative agreement

Consortium Agreements- must complete by the first day of class at UND
